Southeast (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Maryland, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia)

Plains (Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming, Nebraska, Kansas, Colorado, Oklahoma, Texas, and New Mexico)

Southwest (New Mexico, Utah, Colorado, Arizona, some of Mexico)

Great Basin (Nevada, half of Utah, and sections of Idaho, Wyoming, Oregon, and California)

California

Northwest Coast (Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and the Canadian province of British Columbia)

Plateau (Montana, Idaho, Oregon, and Washington and the Canadian province of British Columbia)

*Ask open ended questions and build on them, examples:

Was it easy to know the location of your tribe, did you know the region?

What tribes are in your region?

Did you know that some tribal regions overlap into other states?

What are some traditions or cultural practices of the tribes in your region?

What are some cultural practices you do if you are not living in your tribal region? Are you able to practice them? How do you think you could participate in your practice if you are not able to now?

Tribal Communities- where do you live closes to?

Puyallup, Nisqually, Muckleshoot, Quinault...I don't know

*Ask open ended questions and build on them, examples:

Do you know the tribal community?

Do you not know the closest tribal community?

Do you participate in tribal events? What are they?

Do you travel and participate in other tribal communities?

If you did not know about events, how do you think you could find out?
